

Contact form for the tutoring program of the refugees network

"Refugees Welcome to Ilmenau"

With this form we will contact you and give you information about the tutoring project. By clicking on "Submit" you confirm that we may use and store your data for these purposes. You can withdraw your consent and have your data deleted.

What data do we collect and why (for what purpose)?

We collect and store the following data from you:

- Your name - to contact you
- telephone number, e-mail address and preferred means of communication - to contact you
- the subjects in which you are looking for/can provide tutoring - for referral purposes
- your school level - for further referral

This data is used on the one hand for contacting and communicating in the tutoring project and on the other hand for assigning and allocating special learning groups or referrals for special requests.

Who may use the data?

We use your email address to inform you about current information of the tutoring project or to contact you. Of course, you can also revoke your consent (right of objection Art. 21 DSGVO) or ask us to delete your data (Art. 17 DSGVO).

How long do we store the data?

Until you object (Art. 21 DSGVO) and you have your data deleted (Art. 17 DSGVO).

Your data protection rights

You are entitled to so-called data subject rights, i.e. rights that you can exercise as a person affected in an individual case. They result from the DSGVO:

- Right to information (Art. 15 DSGVO) about the personal data stored concerning you.
- Right to rectification (Art. 16 DSGVO) of incorrect data concerning your person
- Right to erasure (Art. 17 DSGVO) of your data, if certain reasons for deletion exist. This is particularly the case if they are no longer necessary for the purpose for which they were originally collected or processed.
- Right of objection (Art. 21 DSGVO): if we process your personal data within the framework of a balancing of interests on the basis of our overriding legitimate interest, you have the right to object to its processing at any time for reasons arising from your particular situation with effect for the future. If you exercise your right to object, we will generally stop processing the data concerned.
- You are also entitled to other rights of the data subject, in particular the right to restriction of data processing, objection and data portability, in accordance with the provisions of Art. 12 - 23 DSGVO.

You also have the right to complain to the competent data protection supervisory authority, the Thuringian Data Protection Commissioner, if you believe that the processing of your data is not permitted under data protection law. The complaint to the supervisory authority can be made informally.
